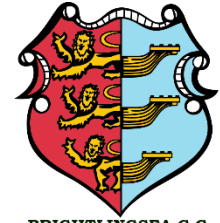

Changing & Showering Guidelines & Policy

The England & Wales Cricket Board (ECB) states that all affiliated clubs must have a Changing Policy. This applies to the arrangements made for adults and children using changing facilities. The ECB states that clubs have to make arrangements so that children and adults do not use the same changing facilities at the same time.

Following ECB best practice principles, the following guidelines will be in place;

- Adults and children must not change between non-playing clothing and playing kit in the same changing room at the same time.
- Children will be advised to arrive and leave in playing kit when playing in open age cricket.
- Adults and children should never shower at the same time in the same changing room.
- Where a mixed gender team represents the Club, then an alternative changing area should be provided for each gender, or players should be advised to arrive/leave in playing kit.
- Mobile phones are not to be used for photography or filming in the changing rooms.
- If any player, especially a child, is uncomfortable changing and/or showering at the Club, no pressure should be placed on them to do so.
